





Profit: \$475  
33.93% profit margin.

Oh and the buyer wants another Tag Heuer as well. He's texting me tomorrow with the exact model and details and wants me to find one for him!!



Hold time: 2 weeks





Tag Heuer Aquaracer Black Phantom

In: \$1,100 + \$50 for the bracelet and NATO

Total Cost: \$1,150

Out: \$1,450 local sale

ROI: ~26%

Time listed: 6 weeks

I found this timepiece was a harder sell than my last for a few reasons. It being black instead of stainless or gold definitely narrowed the buyers down significantly, but the hardest sell was the canvas strap it originally came with. Including the matching bracelet and NATO ended up being the final selling point on this one.





I love WC! Got paid quite well to wear a Panerai 561 this weekend. The only reason it came to me at such a great price is because of my local network. My watchmaker directs every watch he hears about for sale to me!

Bought this on Friday evening for \$2300 with:

- boxes,
- an extra Panerai leather strap,
- stamped warranty book (matching numbers of course),
- instruction manual,
- strap change tool and Panerai bezel cover

Photographed it Saturday, carefully pointing out any possible flaw it had.

Listed it for sale at \$3800 Saturday evening, with every possible flaw listed in the post. Posting had 40 photos, some for detail, and some to make it look awesome.

Two hours after listing, I had a buyer for asking price, a 767 captain who loves watches and wants to know what else I've got in Breitling or Longines, specifically. Got paid via PayPal on Monday morning and shipped it out!

Made \$1500, AND got to experience my first hand-wind-only mechanical movement, as well as my first Panerai in-house movement. VERY cool piece.
